**APPLICANTS CURRENTLY REGISTERED IN ANOTHER REGULATED CANADIAN JURISDICTION**

This application package is for a current holder of a registration in good standing, that is the same or substantially similar to the registration category you are applying for in Saskatchewan, with one of the following Canadian regulated jurisdictions:

- British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, or Quebec.

**To apply for the non-practising, temporary-CPP or temporary visiting clinician category, contact CSASK directly for an application package. For all other registration categories, proceed with the online application.**

**PRIOR TO STARTING YOUR APPLICATION:**

- To avoid delays in processing your application, review the “Registration Requirements and Applications Information” document.
- All application forms are available under the “Application Forms” section at [csask.ca](http://csask.ca).
- Information requested from a third-party, university, regulatory body or college, **must** be sent directly to the CSASK office.
- CSASK will only begin reviewing your application once payment of the **non-refundable** application and assessment fees, and **all** required documents have been received.
- CSASK will notify you if more information is required.

CSASK will only issue a practice permit once all the requirements for registration have been met (including payment of the licence fee).

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- Audiologists and speech-language pathologists **must be approved** for registration with CSASK prior to working/volunteering and using the professional titles in Saskatchewan.
- Start the application process early to allow for sufficient processing time, prior to the anticipated employment or volunteer start date.

**APPLICATIONS ARE PROCESSED WITHIN 10 BUSINESS DAYS ONCE PAYMENT AND ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE RECEIVED.**

**TO APPLY COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:**

Complete and submit the online application by clicking on the “Apply Now” link on the CSASK Applicants page, then click “sign up” when brought to the applicant portal to set up your account.	
In addition to the sections in the online application, applicants <b>must</b> arrange for the following documents to be sent <b>directly to CSASK</b> by the third-party:

Verification of Registration	Request a verification of registration from all Canadian regulated jurisdictions in which you are currently registered.
