APPLICANTS CURRENTLY REGISTERED IN ANOTHER REGULATED JURISDICTION

Temporary Registration and Licence: a CSASK temporary registration and licence is available to audiologists or speech-language pathologists who are currently licensed in another regulated jurisdiction and who wish to practise in Saskatchewan for a temporary reason. This registration and licence is approved for a defined purpose and period of time and is subject to conditions or limitations. This licence is not renewed.

Cross-Provincial Practice Licence: the Cross-Provincial Practice licence is available to audiologists or speech-language pathologists who are currently registered in Alberta, Manitoba, New-Brunswick or Ontario who wish to provide services virtually or in person to clients/patients in Saskatchewan to a maximum of 200 hours during the period for which the licence is issued. This licence is not renewed.

PRIOR TO STARTING YOUR APPLICATION:

- To avoid delays in processing your application, review the following document and the *CSASK Fee Schedule*. For a Cross-Provincial Practice licence, also review the *CPP supporting documents*
- Information requested from a third-party, university, regulatory body or college, **must** be sent directly to the CSASK office.
- CSASK will only begin reviewing your application once payment of the **non-refundable** application fee and licence fee, and **all** required documents have been received.
- CSASK will notify you if more information is required.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Audiologists and speech-language pathologists **must be approved** for licensure with CSASK prior to working/volunteering and using the professional titles in Saskatchewan.
- Start the application process early to allow for sufficient processing time, prior to the anticipated employment or volunteer start date.

APPLICATIONS ARE PROCESSED WITHIN 10 BUSINESS DAYS ONCE PAYMENT AND ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE RECEIVED.

Verification of Registration	Temporary for visiting clinician: Applicants request a verification of registration from all Canadian regulated jurisdictions in which they are currently registered. Cross-Provincial Practice (CPP): Applicants request a CPP verification from one of the following primary jurisdictions: Alberta, Manitoba, Ontario or New Brunswick.
