Title

1 These Bylaws may be cited as *The CSASK Fee Bylaws, 2026*.

Definitions

2 In these bylaws:

- (a) “Act” means *The Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists Act*;
- (b) “council” means the council of CSASK;
- (c) “CSASK” means the College of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists of Saskatchewan continued pursuant to section 3 of the Act;
- (d) “registrant” means a person who is registered as a member of CSASK.

Application

3 The non-refundable application fee to accompany each application:

- (a) for practising, provisional and non-practising registration is \$250;
- (b) for temporary registration is \$0; and
- (c) for cross-provincial practice licensure is \$150.

Assessment

4(1) The non-refundable assessment fee to accompany each application for registration is:

- (a) \$300 for graduates from an accredited Canadian university program, who are more than three years post graduation, and who are not currently registered in another Canadian regulated jurisdiction;
- (b) \$200 for graduates from an un-accredited Canadian university program;
- (c) \$650 for graduates from an accredited American university program;
- (d) \$1350 for graduates from all other international programs.

(2) A \$30 non-refundable criminal record check fee will accompany each application for registration.

Initial registration and licensure

5 The fee for initial registration and for the relevant licence to practice in the initial registration year in the case of an application in 2026 or a subsequent year is:

- (a) \$950 in the case of a person who applies between January 1 and March 31;
- (b) \$712.50 in the case of a person who applies between April 1 and June 30;
- (c) \$475.00 in the case of a person who applies between July 1 and September 30; and
- (d) \$237.50 in the case of a person who applies on or after October 1.

Renewal of annual licence

6(1) The annual fee for a practising or provisional licence is \$950 effective January 1, 2026.

(2) Where it has been five or more years since the registrant last provided a criminal record check, the annual licence fee will include the registrant criminal record check fee.

Non-practising renewal

7 The annual non-practising fee is the amount equal to half of the annual fee for a practising licence.

Temporary licence

8 The temporary licence fee is \$90 per month.

Cross-provincial practice licence

9 The cross-provincial practice licence fee is \$100.

Late renewal

10(1) All annual renewal requirements (including fees) for non-practising, provisional and practising registrants are submitted on or before December 1.

(2) A registrant who submits the renewal requirements and/or fee:

- (a) between December 2 and December 31 shall, in addition to the required renewal fee, pay a late fee equivalent to half of the renewal fee;

Unlicensed Registrants

10.1 An unlicensed registrant seeking licensure in accordance with section 12(4) of the CSASK Regulatory Bylaws shall pay:

- (a) the required licence fee, and
- (b) an administration fee of \$625.

Reinstatement

11 Any person who has been expelled pursuant to the Act and desires to be re-instated shall pay:

- (a) a \$950 reinstatement application fee; and
- (b) if council approves their reinstatement, a fee equivalent to the fee for initial registration and for the relevant licence to practice in the initial registration year.

Other

12 The following fees apply as indicated:

- (a) verification of registration and/or licensure fee is \$50;
- (b) non-sufficient funds fee is \$50;
- (c) cheque cancellation and re-issuance administrative fee is \$30 and cost-recovery of any related banking fees charged to CSASK;
- (d) the fee for copies of CSASK documents available on the CSASK website or for copies of applicant or registrant records is \$30 for the first 10 pages and \$1 per page for each additional page;
- (e) registrant criminal record check, outside of annual licence renewal, will be set to ensure cost-recovery of any fees charged to CSASK;
- (f) employment advertisement posting fee is \$150 for up to 100 words;
- (g) employment advertisement posting fee is \$175 for 101 to 200 words;
- (h) employment advertisement posting fee is \$200 for 201 to 400 words;
- (i) employment advertisement posting fee is \$250 for 401 to 600 words; and
- (j) employment advertisement posting fee is \$300 for 601 to 800 words.
