OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN

An Audiologist performs clinical audiological services including assessments, diagnoses and treatment for eligible patients with hearing and balance concerns. This also includes tasks such as completing patient reports, educating patients/families, providing hearing related counseling and consultation as well as playing an active role in the Saskatchewan Cochlear Implant Program.

Qualifications:

- Master of Science in Audiology (Audiology (MSc))

License & Membership:

- Must be eligible for, and licensed by, the College of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists of Saskatchewan (CSASK)

Benefits and Incentives:

- Hiring incentive and relocation assistance of up to \$18,000 may be available based on location
- Defined benefit and pension plan
- Paid annual vacation
- MyWellbeing Program: resiliency resources, mental health & family supports
- Extended health and dental plan

Audiologists working with the SHA are unionized employees and are members of the Health Sciences Association of Saskatchewan (HSAS).
