OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN

Speech Language Pathologists work in hospital and clinical settings throughout the province with the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) as part of a multidisciplinary health-care team in order to provide the best patient care. Speech Language Pathologists work in shifts in order to provide health-care coverage based on the needs of the facility or clinic and this may include days and weekends. Opportunities to grow as a Speech Language Pathologist include taking advanced courses to work in specialized areas such as pediatrics and pursuing management and leadership positions.

Qualifications:

- Master of Speech Language Pathology

License & Membership:

- Must be eligible for, and licensed by, the College of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists of Saskatchewan (CSASK)

Benefits and Incentives:

- Hiring incentive and relocation assistance of up to \$23,000 may be available based on location
- Defined benefit pension plan
- Paid annual vacation
- MyWellbeing Program: resiliency resources, mental health & family supports
- Extended health and dental plan
